Phone alert system

In case of an emergency, one of the following prerecorded messages are sent to the phones on file with MLRMA. My cell phone number 724 596-2985 will be displayed.

- This is a test of the Fox Hills emergency notification system.
- This is the Fox Hills emergency notification system. Be alert, an emergency is in progress.
- This is the Fox Hills emergency notification system. We have a fire emergency, leave the area immediately.
- This is the Fox Hills emergency notification system. Shelter in place.
- This is the Fox Hills emergency notification system. Emergency is cleared.

In case of an emergency, call me at the number above, the MLRMA VP, or the MLRMA president, who have access to the website for sending alerts.

Checklist in case of an emergency in the Fox Hills

When **calling 911** to report an emergency, please provide our **zip code, 87047**, our **community name, Fox Hills**, and the **road and cross roads** where the emergency is in progress.

Call Hasso Weiland (724 596-2985), current MLRMA president (or current MLRMA VP (Buddy Anderson, 505 681-5825) to **send out an emergency phone message**.

Act yourself or name someone from our neighborhood at the scene to be the “**on-scene commander**”. That person should help make roads clear of people and vehicles so the emergency vehicles can access the area easily.

In case of a house fire:

- Ensure that **power is turned off** (flip main breaker).
- Ensure that **gas is turned off** (typically a valve between tank and house). ○ If possible, close all doors and windows. If neighbors attempt to fight the fire, **DO NOT open or break windows** which allow more air to feed the fire.

If you need to leave the premisses and have a ladder which can reach the roof, put that one up. The emergency responders can react much faster this way.
